#### Duos Age Categories (add ages of both dancers and divide by 2)

Junior: Age 0-12 / Teenage: Age 13-17 / Open: Age 18+ / Senior: Age 45+

Your age on 1st September 2021 determines which division you will dance in for the competition year for example.

### ***Syllabus & Dress Codes***

1. World Dance Masters dress code will be enforced. Reasonable dispensation will be given regarding shoes, however “Takkies” are not allowed. (Except for Funky Youth section and “Street” Style) – Intermediate and above dancers are expected to wear boots for all Country dances.
2. World Dance Masters rules will apply to the competition. These rules are available at [www.wdm.dance](http://www.wdm.dance) or contact Nadia Coen directly for a copy. (082 496 0007 or [ncoen@icon.co.za](mailto:ncoen@icon.co.za))
3. Dancers will not be allowed to discuss their sections with any of the judges before or during the event. This may result in immediate disqualification with no refund on the entry fees.
4. During the prize giving ceremony, dancers must be dressed in one of their competition attires, and with the applicable dance shoes. (Street outfits may NOT be worn for prize giving)
5. All Intermediate, Advanced and All-star male competitors to wear a cowboy hat when the dance is to country music. (ie. appeared in the country charts or performed by a recognised country artist or group).
6. All Intermediate, Advanced and All-star competitors must wear dance boots for all dances done to country music. (ie. appeared in the country charts or performed by a recognised country artist or group).
7. **Bare midriffs** are not allowed. At no point should a costume top ride up to expose a bare midriff. This also applies when dancing funky and street dances.
8. The **10cm above the centre of the knee** rule also applies to shorts.

### ***Right of Admission Reserved.***

1. Right of admission to the competition is strictly reserved.
2. All spectators and dancers must adhere to a smart casual dress code.
3. Strictly no smoking in the venue or in front of exits.

### ***Additional Information***

1. The stage/official area will be reserved for invited guests and competition officials only.
2. No Tuck Shop will be available at the venue. (TBC)  
There are shops and take-a ways close the venue. You are more than welcome to bring your own food and drinks.
3. No Alcohol in the hall during the competitions.
4. Cameras & Video cameras are allowed into the venue; however, we ask you to be considerate of other spectators and respect all competitors.
5. The organisers, LDSA, Ferndale Recreation Centre, or any of the officials will NOT be held responsible for any injury, loss or theft of property by any competitor or spectator.
6. We encourage everyone to **pre-book programmes**. Programmes will be available at the door at a cost of R 20-00 per programme (a limited number of programmes will be available).
7. Due to Covid-19 regulations, we ask you to **pre-book spectators** to ensure correct planning
8. Covid-19 Protocols will apply – everyone to wear a mask except when dancing. Chairs will be socially distanced.
9. Any person **NOT** competing in solo's ie. Only team or Pro-am etc. is required to pay the daily Spectator fee.
